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Discipline and Expulsion Policies

We are required by Children and Families to provide parents with written policies regarding discipline and expulsion practices. Please sign this form and return with your child’s application.

Our program uses a proper approach to discipline. Children occasionally need discipline. Children are taught which behaviors are inappropriate, and why and given alternatives that are acceptable. In this way the behavior is being changed, without making the child feel bad. It also helps them build self-esteem and teach them how to handle difficult situations themselves.

We welcome the ideals of parents, so feel free to share them with us.

1st – Child will be corrected/ redirected and asked to change their behavior.

2nd Child will be redirected from the situation.

3rd Childs parent will be contacted if behavior is not corrected.

4th Child becomes very violent to students/staff, parents are asked to pick up the child and child maybe expulse from school.

The school very seldom, if at all, needs to use expulsion as a way to correct child’s behavior. Student’s behavior is usually corrected once the parent gets involved.
